



Walcha – Day Trip

1. **Apsley Falls** (Oxley Wild Rivers National Park): A 15-min drive east of Walcha with sealed access.
2. **Tia Falls** (Oxley Wild Rivers National Park): A 30-min drive east of Walcha (6km unsealed road suitable for 2WD vehicles) with a 30-minute return walk to falls.
3. **Open Air Gallery:** Take a walk around the streets and along the river to admire over 58 sculptures by renowned local, national and international artists. Brochure and map available at Visitor Information Centre or download at www.walchansw.com.au/art-in-walcha.
4. **Historical Building Walk:** Approximately 1 hour. Brochure available at Visitor Information Centre or download at www.walchansw.com.au/walchas-historic-buildings.
5. **Dine out** at one of our many cafés and country pubs.
6. **Engage** in some retail therapy and browse a range of boutique shops, craft stores, art galleries, and antiques & collectables stores.
