Oxley Wild Rivers National Park

Apsley Falls Campground – via Oxley Hwy 20 km east of Walcha

Tia Falls Campground – via Oxley Hwy 43 km east of Walcha

Youdales Hut Campground – via Oxley Hwy / Kangaroo Flat Rd 101 km east of Walcha * Low range 4WD only – NO trailers
